It is a condition of this letter of credit that it will be automatically extended for additional periods of five years from the current or any future expiration date unless we notify you in writing at least two years prior to the current expiration date that we elect not to renew this letter of credit for such additional period.

Except insofar as otherwise expressly stated herein, this letter of credit is subject to the Uniform Customs and Practice for Documentary Credits, 2007 revision, International Chamber of Commerce Publication No. 600. This letter of credit shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the state of Wisconsin, including the Uniform Commercial Code as in effect in the state of Wisconsin.

If you return this original Letter of Credit and Amendment(s) prior to the then current expiration date with your intent to terminate same, it must be accompanied by your originally signed letter, addressed and sent directly to xxxxx, indicating you no longer require this letter of credit and release xxxxx of our obligation hereunder.
